Eligibility for Maharashtra Police Constables Pre-Recruitment Training for Minorities

1. Annual family income of candidate shall not be more than Rs.2.5lakhs
2. Candidate should belong to minority community (Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, Sikhs, Parsis and Jain)
3. Age: between 18yrs. To 25yrs.
4. Minimum Height for male candidate: 165cm.; Chest for male candidate: 79cm. (84cm expanded).
5. Minimum Height for female candidate: 155cm.
6. Candidate should have passed H.S.C. exam
7. Candidate should be physically & medically fit in all respects
8. Candidate should attach true copies of educational qualification, domicile certificate, employment exchange registration card, etc.

Features of Training Program for Maharashtra Police Constables Pre-Recruitment Training for Minorities

1. Duration: 2 months
2. 3 hours classroom training + 2 hours physical training daily
3. Selected candidate will get stipend of Rs.1500/- per month
4. Training Institute will provide tea & refreshments daily after physical training
5. Selected candidate will be paid lump sum grant of Rs.1000/- for purchasing uniform kit (uniform, shoes, socks, vest, etc)
6. Selected candidate has to make his/her own lodging & boarding arrangements during training

All candidates must remain present at the following address on **July 27th, 2010 at 10a.m.** along with documents mentioned above with application form:

1. Mumbai/Mumbai Suburban: Police Parade Ground, Naigaon (Dadar), Mumbai

2. Other Districts: Police Parade Ground at District Headquarters
